Multi Engine Instrument Rating

What is a ME IR?

The Multi Engine Instrument Rating (formerly MECIR) allows pilots to fly in Instrument Meteorology Conditions (IMC) in a Multi Engine Aeroplane (MEA). Flying IFR adds an additional level of safety in deteriorating meteorological conditions as well as enhanced procedural performance. The MECIR is also the minimum requirement for most charter operators.

At a Glance:

- A MEA IR Rating allows the holder to act as PIC of an aircraft certified to fly IFR anywhere in Australia
- The MEA IR Rating includes all 2D and 3D approaches, as well as azimuth and course deviation indicator.
- Training at Command Flight Training offers the experience of flying IFR in the Adelaide Class C airspace, whilst saving time and money operating out of a CTAF aerodrome.

What is involved?

The CFT MEA IR training syllabus is CASA approved and allows for the maximum level of flexibility and tailoring to the student's individual needs. The minimum requirements for an issue of a MEA IR are, our training includes both training for the MEA Class Rating as well as the Instrument Rating:

- 40 hours instrument time total
- 10 hours cross-country dual instrument time in a multi engine aircraft
- 5 hours night flight total
- 1 hours of night flight as pilot in command
- 50 hours cross-country flight time as pilot in command

What does it cost?
